



Server Operating System

- Support Novell but recommend Windows
 - Multi-processors
 - Dynamic caching
 - 2 GB limit on Novell
 - *The Raiser's Edge for the Web*
- NT vs. Windows 2000



Workstation Operating System

- Windows 95 not supported
- Windows 98 supported but not recommended
- Windows NT or 2000 recommended

Being a "database manager" is a different role with different responsibilities than being the fundraising team's chief writing queries, creating reports, and making mailing lists. It's long been different than system configuration, policy and procedure, development documentation, liaison, and more. This session will discuss what it means to be a "database manager" the same since moving from Raiser's Edge 7 and database view to the full web view. The role has changed to make the role more knowledgeable, engaged, and technical. This session is for Raiser's Edge consultants, thinkers and get a chance to ask questions and share ideas.

 - This takes time, thought, being methodical, working with your users


- Talk to your supervisor about this

- Believe everything you read or hear
- Buy the hype

- Only pay attention to *your* tasks and uses

You absolutely *must*...

- Security
- Settings
 - Including within the constituent records
- Table management
- Custom field (Attribute) management

I *suggest* you do in the web view

- Query...
 - A word about Query Lists...
- Anyone with a portfolio should be using
 - Constituents, Actions, Notes, Opps, Lists (all 4), Work Center
 - But do NOT export lists!! Especially for mailings!!
- Leadership and fundraisers should be using standard dashboards*

I *suggest* you do in the web view

- Event management and online event registration forms
- Online donation forms if you can deal with donors and gifts
- Reports if you must export them to Excel
- Duplicate detection and merging is better

Consider doing in the web view

- Very specific gift tasks: in-person credit card, auto RG pays, auto Pledge pays, online donation and event reg form payments; otherwise wait for new grid batch experience
- Email?
- Marketplace apps like LetterBox
- Emailed receipts for offline gifts

Consider doing in the web view

- Home page
- Dashboard builder and Insight Designer
- Prospect Insights
- Power Automate and Power BI
- Post to GL if you use Blackbaud Financial Edge

Don't do in the web view


- Day-to-day constituent maintenance
- Gift entry other than previously noted
- Mailings
- AI Acknowledgements
- Address Finder
- Workflow designer
- Giving statements

Do in the database view

- Everything else!
- Do what you can in the web view and stop using the database view for that, otherwise use the database view as always
- Exporting, mailings, globals, constituent entry and maintenance, gift entry, reporting, importing, plug-ins, CFA maintenance, Address Finder, Deceased Finder?, acknowledgements, receipts, reminders, membership, volunteers, ...


Put another way, use the db view for...

- Almost everything in Records
- Everything in Export (NOT web view Lists or Query!)
- Everything in Reports unless the goal is an Excel file
- Everything in Mail
- Most everything in Batch
- Everything in Admin except perhaps Post to GL



Use the database view for

- Most everything in Configuration
- [Drop Dashboards in db view]
- Everything in Data Health Center
- Online Express, perhaps, for email and online donation forms
- Plug-ins, such as ImportOmatic, Importacular, Unpost, etc.
